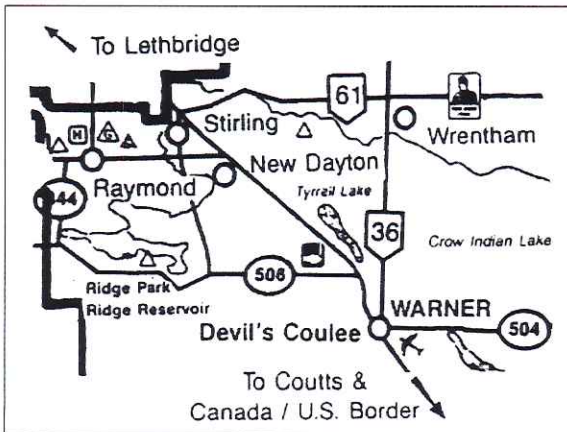


What's New At Devil's Coulee

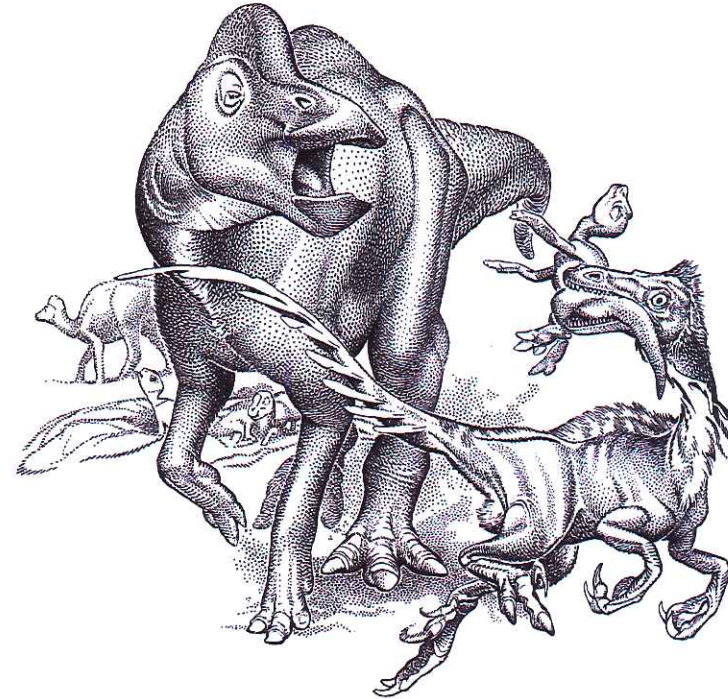

Devil's Coulee Museum & Site Tours

As one of two nesting sites discovered in North America, Devil's Coulee is a gem of a small museum, and boasts exceptional interpretive staff.

It offers intimate guided site tours, lots of hands-on activities for the little ones and an opportunity to visit the site with guided two hour tours. At the site you will learn to identify fossils in their original setting and discover the geological forces that shaped the coulees.

Summer Camps at Devil's Coulee are Back!

Devil's Coulee has a variety of summer camps for children of all ages:

- 1/2 Day camps: Tuesdays from July 2nd, to August 13th. \$25/camper
- One day Camps: Every Other Thursday from July 11th to August 22nd. \$55/camper
- Two day Camps: Every Other Wednesday and Thursday from July 17th to August 14th. \$125/camper
- Activities include: snacks, science experiments, crafts, games, museum and site tour, and so much more...
